Subject: **PRE-BID MEETING OF THE PROCUREMENT COMMITTEE FOR ILLUMINATION EQUIPMENT FOR ILLUMINATION OF VARIOUS HERITAGE SITES (DATED JULY 31, 2023) IN KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA UNDER PROJECT MANAGEMENT UNIT (PMU) KITE DOT.**

A Pre bid meeting of the Procurement Committee was held on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2023 at 1130hrs in the Project Management Unit (PMU) for the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Integrated Tourism Project KITE Department of Tourism.

The participants of the meeting were welcomed by the Procurement Expert, PMU KITE DoT, and informed that the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa had received Credit of US\$ 70 million from the International Development Association (IDA) of the World Bank Group for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Integrated Tourism Development Project (KITE) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for "**Illumination Equipment for Illumination of Various Heritage sites in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**" and the instant procurement is carried out in accordance with the Request for Bids (RFB) method set out in the World Bank Procurement Regulations (Procurement in Investment Project Financing, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services, July 2016 Revised November 2017, August 2018, and November 2020) following the National market approach.

The advertisement and issued Request for Bids (RFB) bidding documents which were already made available on the project website [www.kite.kptourism.com](http://www.kite.kptourism.com), were briefly explained,
